

ENGLEWOOD HEALTH OFFERS FREE PROSTATE CANCER SCREENING ON THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 20TH

September is Prostate Cancer Awareness Month. According to the Prostate Cancer Foundation, a man will be diagnosed with prostate cancer every three minutes. However, prostate cancer is 100% treatable if detected early. The goal of screening for prostate cancer is to find cancers that may be at high risk for spreading if not treated, and to find them early before they spread.

For men who have consulted with their medical provider and decided to be screened for prostate cancer, on Thursday, September 20th, Englewood Health is offering FREE Prostate Cancer Screening for all men ages 50-70 (40 if African American or with a family history of prostate cancer). The screening will involve a PSA blood test and a digital rectal exam and will be held by appointment only

from 12:00 to 8:00 pm. Englewood Health is located at 350 Engle Street, Englewood, NJ.

Registration for the screening is required by September 18th. To register/make an appointment, visit englewoodhealth.org/prostate2018.
