ORDINANCE 07:08

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN EMERGENCY
APPROPRIATION N.J.S. 40A:4-53**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Norwood, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey that pursuant to N.J.S. 40A:4-53 (Ch. 48, P.L. 1956 as amended by Ch. 144 P.L. and Ch. 38 P.L. 1969) the sum of \$225,000 is hereby appropriated for the engagement of special consultants for Revaluation of Real Property and shall be deemed a special emergency appropriation as defined and provided for in N.J.S. 41A:4-55.

The authorization to finance the appropriation shall be provided for in succeeding annual budgets by the inclusion of at least 1/5 of the amount authorized pursuant to this act (N.J.S. 40A:4-55).

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall take effect at the time and in the manner provided by law.
