ORDINANCE NO. 07:31

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 85 OF THE CODE OF
THE BOROUGH OF NORWOOD REGULATING ANIMALS, REQUIRING DOG
AND CAT LICENSING**

WHEREAS, the purpose of this ordinance is to increase the fees for the issuance of dog and cat licenses in accordance with N.J.S.A.4:19-15, et seq.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Norwood as follows:

Section 1: Section 85-2D-Fees of the Code of the Borough of Norwood shall be revised to amend the fees charged for the issuance of a dog license to:

1. For a non-spayed or non-neutered dog of reproductive age, the fee for the license shall be \$13.20 for each dog of licensing age.
2. For a spayed or neutered dog, the fee for a license shall be \$10.20 for each dog of licensing age. To qualify for such reduced fee, the owner shall be required to submit to the Secretary to the Board of Health a certificate signed by a licensed veterinarian stating that the dog has been spayed or neutered.

Section 2: Section 85-17G of the Code of the Borough of Norwood shall be revised to amend the fees charged for the issuance of cat licenses to:

- G. License fee schedule. A license shall be issued after payment of a fee of \$8.00 for each un-neutered cat and \$6.00 for each neutered cat.

Section 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances that are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of any inconsistencies.

Section 5: The provisions of this ordinance are severable. If any part of this ordinance is declared to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court, the remaining parts of this ordinance will remain in full force and effect.


Section 6: This ordinance shall take effect upon final approval and publication, according to law.


