

**Borough Of Norwood  
Ordinance No. 09:08**

**An Ordinance Amending Chapter 198 of the Code of  
the Borough of Norwood Titled "Solid Waste"**

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of this ordinance is to update the Borough's recycling ordinance to comply with the latest revisions to the Updated Statewide Solid Waste Management Plan and the Bergen County District Solid Waste Management Plan.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Norwood, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1: The Code of the Borough of Norwood ("Code") is amended so that §198-10 is amended to add the following definitions:

"Type 1 plastic containers" means polyethylene terephthalate containers, such as soft drink bottles, and salad dressing, peanut butter, and popcorn containers.

"Type 2 plastic containers" means high density polyethylene containers, such as milk jugs, and water, detergent, bleach, and other cleaning agent bottles.

Section 2: The Code §198-12(B)(1), listing the mandatory recycling materials for residential users, is amended to add the following:

- (k) Construction and demolition debris.
- (l) Corrugated cardboard.

(m) Mixed paper.

(n) Type 1 and 2 plastic containers.

Section 3: The Code §198-13(B)(1), listing the mandatory recycling materials for non-residential users, is amended to add the following:

(13) Type 1 and 2 plastic containers.

Section 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances that are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of any inconsistencies.

Section 5: The provisions of this ordinance are severable. If any part of this ordinance is declared to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court, the remaining parts of this ordinance will remain in full force and effect.


Section 6: This ordinance shall take effect upon final approval and publication, according to law.
